Cookie Bake Express

When the families come home from the hospital, nothing tastes better than a homemade cookie. Your group can bake cookies for the families in our Viking kitchens and prepare them in individual bags for the families to enjoy. It is a great team-building event that only takes a couple of hours.

Each group provides all food ingredients and sandwich bags. You can bake the cookies from scratch or bring in commercially prepared cookie dough from a grocery store (Nestle Toll-House, Pillsbury, etc.).

FedExFamilyHouse will provide the food preparation gloves and cookie baking sheets.

Popular cookie choices are chocolate chip, sugar, oatmeal raisin and butterscotch/toffee. Please be aware of common allergies such as nuts when deciding what type of cookies to bake. We do not recommend baking any cookies with nuts or nut products. Groups can prepare as many cookies as their time and budget allows.

Supplies for Cookie Bake Express

Items Your Group Provides

- If cooking from scratch, all baking ingredients
or
- Pre-prepared cookie dough from grocery store
(must come from a commercial, health department inspected kitchen; cannot be prepared in individual homes)
- Sandwich bags to package cookies for individuals

Items FedExFamilyHouse Provides

- Food preparation gloves *(gloves must be worn at all times when handling food)*
- Cookie baking sheets/pans
- Cooking utensils such as spatulas, spoons, etc.
- Viking ovens
